**WHEREAS**, The City Council of the City of Seminole adopted Resolution No. 03-2017 on September 7, 2017, pursuant to Chapter 252.38(3)(a), Florida Statutes, and Section 3-9 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Seminole; and


**WHEREAS**, Hurricane Irma negatively affects the health, safety, and welfare of citizens and visitors of the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Leslie Waters, Mayor of the City of Seminole, Florida do hereby proclaim that Hurricane Irma poses a serious threat to the lives and property of residents of the City of Seminole and that a State of Local Emergency shall be declared, effective immediately, for all territory within the corporate boundaries of the City of Seminole.

**IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED THAT** the enforcement of the provisions of Resolution No. 03-2017, shall be in effect until the termination of the State of Local Emergency.
