

**WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES II

Mayor Waters called the meeting to order at 8:40 p.m.

1. WASTE MANAGEMENT PROPOSED AGREEMENT:

City Manager Edmunds informed Council that a draft agreement was reached with Waste Management Inc. to establish a new rate as directed by Council. Draft of proposed agreement includes a vendor provided 65 gallon totter for single stream recycling services for single family residence and no changes for current collection services.

Discussed was a fee analysis that indicated that the newly proposed residential rate, which includes a 65 gallon single stream recycling service, provides the lowest rate in Pinellas County.


2. HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS PLAN:
