A Workshop of the Seminole City Council was held on Tuesday, March 10, 2015 in the City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 – 113th Street North, Seminole, Florida.

Mayor Waters called the workshop to order at 8:27 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

Present were: Councilor Roger Edelman, Vice-Mayor Thomas Barnhorn, Mayor Leslie Waters, Councilor Chris Burke, Councilor James Quinn, Councilor Bob Matthews, City Manager Frank Edmunds and City Attorney John Elias. Not present Councilor Patricia Plantamura and City Clerk.

TOPIC: RESOLUTION NO. XX-2015 REGARDING RED, WHITE AND BLUE INITIATIVE

City Manager Edmunds explained the attached draft resolution authorizes the implementation of the Red, White and Blue Initiative. The draft resolution outlines how the city could support the initiative. Council consensus would determine whether to move forward with the resolution.

Council members were in agreement with the proposed resolution with the following reservations; the removal of the Chief Osceola logo from the city's letterhead, signage and lapel pins; conflicts with the city's current banners and cost to implement the proposed resolution.

City Manager Edmunds explained the resolution recommends incorporating the Red, White and Blue Initiative and not the removal of city's seal. The Red, White and Blue would be incorporated as a background or outline on city stationery and other pertinent items; the flag banners would replace the current city banners and be placed on major intersections and other locations.

After some discussion, Council agreed to increase the number of banners and to purchase flag lapel pins. Council consensus was to present the Resolution with the noted changes at the next council meeting.

TOPIC: St. Petersburg College/City Partnership Scholarship

City Manager Edmunds explained the city would provide a 12 month, full-time employment opportunity for a graduating student from the Public Policy Program. Tentatively, the program has been named Public Service Associate in Training Scholarship. A budget of \$30,000.00 has been designated for this position. Council consensus is to move forward with the program.

TOPIC: Community Building Rental Space



TOPIC: Chapter 70


City Manager Edmunds requested Chapter 70 be postponed until the next regular meeting date.
