

**WORKSHOP II MINUTES  
SEMINOLE CITY COUNCIL  
AUGUST 25, 2015**

A Workshop of the Seminole City Council was held on Tuesday, August 25, 2015, at 9:32 p.m., in City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 – 113<sup>th</sup> Street North, Seminole, Florida.

Mayor Waters called the workshop to order at 9:32 p.m.

Present were: Mayor Leslie Waters, Vice-Mayor Thom Barnhorn, City Clerk Patty Beliveau, Councilor Chris Burke, City Attorney Jay Daigneault, Councilor Roger Edelman, Councilor Bob Matthews, Councilor Jim Quinn, and City Manager Ann Toney-Deal. Councilor Patricia Plantamura was not present.

Discussion - Frank Edmunds' Retirement Party

Mayor Waters asked Council to share their ideas regarding Mr. Edmunds' retirement gathering. Mayor Waters suggested council turn over the planning of the event to City Manager Toney-Deal and city staff to work on the event.

City Manager Toney-Deal explained that there are funds in the contingency account that could be allocated for the event. She also stated Administration has received \$1,500 from two vendors and another vendor may be interested in hosting/sponsoring a refreshment/food station.


Councilor Matthews suggested Administration contact Mr. Edmunds for his list of attendees and to also include city staff, vendors, commissioners and members from the FCCMA group.

Councilor Matthews volunteered to donate decorations for the event. Council by consensus agreed to have Councilor Matthews donate the decorations for the reception area.

Council suggested an event budget of \$5,000 with the primary funding sources to be comprised of contributions, donations and sponsorships from the community. There was Council consensus that the City would make up the difference in the event the private sector financial contributions fall short of the \$5,000 budget target.
