

**WORKSHOP MINUTES
SEMINOLE CITY COUNCIL
August 9, 2016**

The Workshop of the Seminole City Council was held on Tuesday, August 9, 2016, in City Hall, City Council Chambers, 9199 - 113th Street North, Seminole, Florida.

Mayor Waters called the meeting to order at 8:20 p.m.

1. WELCOME CENTER (LURIE GRANT) AT WATERFRONT PARK

Mayor Waters recognized City Manager Toney-Deal to explain. City Manager Toney-Deal reviewed the need for pilings and DEP (Department Environment Protection) process for the Welcome Center building at Waterfront Park.

Council discussed the addition of a second story, the building's footprint, a metal roof and the architectural elevation of the Welcome Center building. Public Works Director Hockenbury will re-stake the property and the Welcome Center building so Council can visit the site and view the outline of the building and its location.

Council consensus was to keep the Welcome Center building as a one-story building, that the square footage of 2,880 will remain as previously discussed and the piling placing as proposed/necessary.


2. FACADE IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM


Council consensus was to postpone the Façade Improvement Grant Program agenda item to a future workshop.
