City Manager Toney-Deal asked Council for its authorization to negotiate a proposed Development Agreement with Deloach, Hofstra & Cavonis Law Firm, for the property located at 8640 Seminole Boulevard.




Gulf Coast Consulting, Transportation Planner Robert Pergolizzi explained the details of the proposed two-story building, landscaping, parking, and driveway.
