- **INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FOR ADVANCED TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT / INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM (ATMS/ITS) AND ROADWAY TRANSFER FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL.**


City Manager Toney-Deal explained that the Interlocal Agreement for Advanced Traffic Management / Intelligent Transportation System (ATMS/ITS) was approved on February 3, 2009, and it is to expire on February 3, 2019. The ATMS/ITS is intended to facilitate centralized traffic signal operations on specified County arterial roads and other major thoroughfares including county controlled roadway within municipalities.


Pinellas County Transportation Director Ken Jacobs provided a Project PowerPoint Presentation of the Pinellas Countywide ATMS/ITS system, and its impact to the City of Seminole.

Mr. Jacobs explained the ATMS/ITS system implementation process for Seminole Boulevard and Park Boulevard.
