

ORDINANCE NO. 24-2018

I.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SEMINOLE, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING THE OPERATING BUDGET BY INCREASING GENERAL FUND REVENUES AND EXPENSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, revenues and expenses were originally adopted for the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 through Ordinance 26-2017; and

WHEREAS, the authority for appropriation amendments is provided for in Article IX, Section 9.02 of the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 166.241(4) provides for a municipality to amend its budget at any time during the fiscal year or within 60 days following the end of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Seminole, Pinellas County, Florida to appropriate \$20,944 in General Fund revenue and \$397,614 in General Fund expenditures to the listed accounts.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEMINOLE, PINELLAS COUNTY, FLORIDA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$20,944 is appropriated to account
01-0369-8007 Miscellaneous Revenue \$ 20,944


SECTION 2. The sum of \$397,614 is appropriated to the following accounts
01-0511-8200 Aid to Organization \$ 20,944
01-0516-9903 Hurricane Irma Related Expenses \$376,670


SECTION 3. This Budget Amendment Ordinance provides for the appropriation of revenues and expenditures in the General Fund resulting in a decrease of Fund Balance in the amount of 376,670.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage.
