The City of Seminole and St. Petersburg College are seeking a dedicated volunteer to fill a vacancy on the Library Advisory Board. The LAB is a five-member board that advises the library director on the policies and management of the library. Two members are appointed by Seminole City Council, two are appointed by St. Petersburg College, and one is jointly appointed by the City Council and the College. Board members serve two-year terms and must be available for meetings no less than four (4) times per year and at the direction of the library director as the need may arise.

The current vacancy on the board is for the seat jointly appointed by the City and the College.

- The opportunity to help in guiding the operation and future development of our community library.
