





## TRIP REFUND POLICY

All Senior Trips will require payment at time of registration and are non-refundable. The only exception for a refund is if you find a replacement. No refunds for cancellations on the day of trip!

A Recreation Membership Card is required in order to utilize the Seminole Recreation Center. A Recreation Card is needed for ages three (3) and up. Recreation Memberships can be obtained in the office.

Types of Membership	Price
City of Seminole Resident	<b>FREE</b> - With two (2) proofs of residency such as a Florida driver license, current vehicle registration, current utility bill, or property ad valorem taxes. Valid for two (2) years from date of issue.
Non-Resident Individual	<b>\$120.00</b> - Individuals not paying City of Seminole taxes—valid for one (1) year from date of purchase.
Non-Resident Family	<b>\$360.00</b> - Family of four (4) living in the same household. Each additional family member would be \$25.00. Valid for one (1) year from date of purchase.
Non-Resident Seasonal	<b>\$70.00</b> – Valid from October 1st - April 30th
Military	A resident with a valid Resident Membership Card may enroll a relative on military active duty and their immediate family for a ten (10) week temporary membership card. The enrolled relative must present a military ID at the time of enrollment.
Guests	<b>\$5.00</b> - Anyone utilizing the facility without a membership must pay the guest fee.

## FEES, PROGRAMS, REFUNDS

Fees and programs are subject to change without notice. The Seminole Recreation Center reserves the right to cancel programs as deemed necessary. A full refund will be made in the event a program is cancelled by the Recreation Center prior to the start date. If you are not completely satisfied with a class, notify office staff before the start of the second class and fill out a REFUND REQUEST FORM. A refund check will be generated from the Finance Division within three to four weeks.




